A Message from the SBRGC President

The Holiday season is upon us with just finishing Thanksgiving under state restrictions for COVID-19 and we now headlined into the Christmas season. Before the state imposes new restrictions due to COVID-19 I want to wish everybody a Happy Holiday Season. Keep in mind that the Range will be closed on December 25 and other days may have restricted hours (Christmas Eve, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day) so check the calendar and call the range on the day you plan on going out to verify it's open.

As I write this, there are large sections on California in the Purple Tier and it appears that there is a surge in the reported cases of COVID-19. With the new restrictions it does not impact South Bay Rod & Gun Club as long as we keep following the current guidelines that we have in place. I want to thank all the Range Officers and members for keeping the club safe in these challenging times by enforcing and following the state/county mandate on the wearing of masks as well as following the social distance guidelines.

South Bay Rod & Gun Club is still working to keep up with rapidly changing regulations and orders regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19). For the most up to date information, please visit the club's home page at: www.sbrgc.org which will indicate when things change. As a Club, it is our intent to keep our members and the public safe.

Wearing of Masks is mandatory when you are within 6' of another individual. When you are shooting at your assigned spot you can relax your wear of the mask if you so choose, but once you depart your shooting spot you need to have the mask on. This allows others to move more freely behind the red firing line. RSO's will be enforcing this rule as it is intended to keep everybody safe from spreading the virus from one individual to another individual.

Range/Ranch Development is currently working or tracking the following main projects:

Range Water System. Water well permit modifications has been submitted to the county and we are currently gathering additional information for the county. We have also been working with the California Rural Water Association on obtaining some grants. There is a total of three grants we have applied for. 1) Connect the Range water system with the well at the Ranch. 2) Drill a new well to the west of Range 1. 3) Install a Nitrate filter system to remove the nitrates from the water. If these grants are approved that will help with the funding of the Range water system.

Range Complex Hazmat Assessment is being conducted to determine if an item is standard waste or hazmat waste. Some items like bullets in backstops and brass are already being addressed with a recycling program. The assessment also requires that we take in samples of targets, backers, cartridge boxes or anything else that is placed in the trash that could contain a lead residue and have it tested to determine the amount of lead residue on the item. This measurement applied to the quantity that the club generates in a month by members and guest will determine if we are over the threshold for determination of hazard waste. If we are under the threshold then its business as normal but if we are over the threshold then we half to start a hazard waste program to hand the material.

You are all invited to attend the WORK PARTY on Dec 5, 2020 and then enjoy some shooting in the afternoon. The work will be at both the Range and Ranch. Just email me at president@sbrgc.org so we can ensure we have ample food and dessert. Start time 7:30. Social Distance rules will be followed so bring your mask.

Some of the scheduled work includes:

- ⇒ Tree/Weed trimming at the Ranch
- ⇒ Placement of Base Material for the Maintenance Yard by the tractor
- ⇒ Shooting Table and Number Board Refurbishment by Quonset Hut
- ⇒ Drain Pipe Repair by the Water Tank
- ⇒ Water Pipe Repair by Water Tank for the lower pad
