A Message from the SBRGC President

HAPPY NEW YEAR: The Holiday season is coming to a close as 2020 fades into the sunset. Now we need to hope that 2021 is a better year, hopefully the COVID-19 issues will go away and the club can return to full usage of the range.

This printed edition of the Olde Rod & Gunner is the annual election edition and includes your ballot. Please take some time to read the candidate's biographies and follow the instructions on how to mail your ballot back to us before January 26th.

With the liberal forces in control in a lot of areas of government, we need to watch for the anti-gun bills or movements that will come our way to remove or restrict our 2nd Amendment Rights. Keep in mind that two of California's worst anti-gunners have now moved into a position of power with the new Vice President (Kamala Harris) and the new Health Secretary (Xavier Becerra). Plan on seeing some major changes that you won't like.

Starting in July 2021, you will see a change in one law that will erode your rights. Up to July 2021 you were restricted to only purchasing one handgun from a dealer in 30 days, (30 - 24 Hour Periods, they track this down to the second). Starting in July they will be adding semi-automatic rifle to that mix. Effective July 2021 you can only purchase one handgun or semi-automatic rifle in a 30-day period. Note: Private party are exempt from the law (California Seller to a California Buyer), however out of state Private party sales is still restricted.

I want to thank all the Range Officers and members for keeping the club safe in these challenging times by enforcing and following the state/county mandate on the wearing of masks as well as following the social distance guidelines.

Wearing of Masks is mandatory when you are within 6' of another individual. When you are shooting at your assigned spot you can relax your wear of the mask if you so choose, but once you depart your shooting spot you need to have the mask on. This allows others to move more freely behind the red firing line. RSO's will be enforcing this rule as it is intended to keep everybody safe from spreading the virus from one individual to another individual.

Range/Ranch Development is currently working or tracking the following two main projects:

Range Water System. Water well permit modifications has been submitted to the county and we are currently gathering additional information for the county. The grants that we were seeking will not happen as the money is being diverted to the northern portion of California where the fires have destroyed other water systems. We are currently working to get a Point of Use (POU) water filtering system approved so we can install it.

Range Complex Hazmat Assessment is being conducted to determine if an item is standard waste or hazmat waste. Some items like bullets in backstops and brass are already being addressed with a recycling program. The assessment also requires that we take in samples of targets, backers, cartridge boxes or anything else that is placed in the trash that could contain a lead residue and have it tested to determine the amount of lead residue on the item. This is scheduled for this month for the testing.

You are all invited to attend the WORK PARTY on Jan 2, 2021 and then enjoy some shooting in the afternoon. The work will be at both the Range and Ranch. Just email me at president@sbrgc.org so we can ensure we have ample food and dessert. Start time 7:30. Social Distance rules will be followed so bring your mask.

Some of the scheduled work includes:

- ◇ Relocation of the wood working area from the Quonset Hut to the Maintenance Yard
- ◇ Tree/Weed trimming at the Ranch
- ◇ Leveling of Base Material in the Maintenance Yard by the tractor
- ◇ Shooting Table and Number Board
- ◇ Drain Pipe Repair by the Water Tank
- ◇ Water Pipe Repair by Water Tank for the lower pad
- ◇ Club House Wall Replacement prep work (Roof Tiles removal to reduce weight on wall)
- ◇ Sewer riser repair at the Ranch
